ASABE TO REVISE STANDARD ON DRAIN RESTORATION

ST JOSEPH, MICHIGAN— The American Society of Agricultural and Biological Engineers (ASABE) has initiated the revision of EP511, Drain Restoration after Utility Construction, to include a wider variety of repair material options and newer methodologies available today. The standard will also address considerations for field conditions and updated requirements that affect long-term pipe performance.
