## ASABE WITHDRAWS STANDARD ON FORAGE HARVESTERS, FORAGE TRANSPORTERS AND FORAGE BLOWERS

ST JOSEPH, MICHIGAN— The American Society of Agricultural and Biological Engineers (ASABE) has begun the withdrawal of ASAE S328.3 JUL2003 (R2020) Dimensions for Compatible Operation of Forage Harvesters, Forage Transporters and Forage Blowers.

The content of this standard is now outdated, and manufacturers have indicated that they no longer refer to this standard in the design and manufacture of products it lists. The value of continued reference to this document has been greatly diminished. ASABE maintains historical copies of standards after the withdrawal is complete.

ASABE is recognized worldwide as a standards developing organization for food, agricultural, and biological systems, with more than 280 standards currently in publication. Conformance to ASABE standards is voluntary, except where required by state, provincial, or other governmental requirements, and the documents are developed by consensus in accordance with procedures approved by the American National Standards Institute.
